Dress Code



CONTEXT

A school dress code:

- Fosters and enhances the public image of the school, building an irresistible brand and team spirit.
- > Ensures students are dressed for specific school activities and encourages equity among students.
- Clearly identifies students when they represent or participate in excursions or at school social functions.

DRESS CODE INCLUSIONS

- Children are to adhere to school colours of navy, aqua and orange.
- > Tops are to be official school polo shirts or a plain navy polo shirt.
- Skirts, tracksuit pants, slacks, skorts and shorts should be navy and worn at hip height or above.
- Navy only leggings can be worn under skirts, sport skirts, skorts or shorts.
- Fleecy Jumper/zip up jacket should be the navy uniform jacket. No hoods permitted.
- Appropriate enclosed footwear with socks or strapped sandals, sneakers or shoes.
- > School faction-coloured shirts for faction sports events and the day their class participates in PE.
- > Hair of both sexes is to be tied back and kept clear of the child's eyes.
- > Watches, sleepers or small appropriate ear studs. Front or back of ear studs cannot protrude further than 7mm from ear.
- Medical Alert bracelet, Medical Alert necklaces and /or Medical Alert bangles.
- Students are to wear school reversable bucket hats for all outdoor activities. No Hat Shade Play.

DRESS CODE EXCLUSIONS

- > Skate shoes, thongs, slip-ons, ugg boots, rubber boots, football boots in class, high heels and platform shoes.
- Jewellery and make-up including nail polish are excluded.
- > No caps or non-school issued hats are allowed.
- > Brief shorts, bike pants, board shorts or denim shorts.
- > Clothing with fashion logo's.
- > Clothing with vulgar, lewd or offensive slogans or pictures.
- Tee shirts and long pants not in block school colours including such things as: denim, textured material, patterned material, jeans, camouflage clothing, checked shirts or long coloured multi striped socks.

ADVICE TO STUDENTS ON DRESS CODE

- > Forrestdale Primary School Bucket hat is compulsory all year.
- School uniforms may be ordered through the Forrestdale Primary School P&C.
- > Parents are to be notified of the Dress Code on admission and after any changes are made.

MODIFICATION TO DRESS CODE

- > Students who for Religious, Health or Cultural reasons may need to modify the school dress code are required to make an appointment with the Principal to negotiate alternatives.
- > Parents are required to substantiate the required modification.
- > Staff will be informed of these students.
- It is highly desirable that Kindergarten follow the dress code.

SANCTIONS FOR NON-COMPLIANCE

Students not following the dress code will receive:

- > Counselling from teaching staff on the benefits of a dress code and letters or phone call to the parents.
- If a child is not wearing school colours, they may be offered a loan of school colours for the day, if available.
- > A pass for an agreed length of time for dress modification.
- Where the Principal is of the opinion that: the kind of clothes worn by a student, or if the hairstyle does not comply with the Health Department requirements, the Principal may exclude the student from any particular school activity, in accordance with regulations supported by the Education Act. These include students representing or participating at sports meetings, incursions, excursions and school activities.
- > To avoid sanctions and exclusions from activities, children may be offered appropriate clothes to wear for the duration of the event, given a supply of uniforms are available.

POSITIVE REWARDS OF WEARING THE SCHOOL UNIFORM

- Positive recognition by administration and teachers.
- > The knowledge and pride the students have about belonging to Forrestdale Primary School.
- > Whole school incentive for children abiding by dress code.
